It is perfect for uses that require multiple series of opening and closing.

Shalimar, designed for lining helmets and footwear, will also be present: woven with Microsense yarns for better comfort, a soft touch and easy cleaning. This fabric is also treated with *Sanitized* antibacterial and *2DRY* technology, which allows for fast drying. The fabric is also laminated with filter foams, which make it even more breathable and facilitate the dispersion of moisture; it can also be perforated for additional air passage.

The **Native** line will also be on display: an extensive line made of recycled yarns including several products for the world of industry.

Techtextil provides the ideal stage for these cutting-edge solutions, giving Sitip the opportunity to demonstrate its commitment to innovation, quality, customer satisfaction and responsible production.
